



REFEREE CLINIC GUIDELINES

Effective July 13, 2003

QUADRANT CLINICS

WSSA sponsors a maximum of four (4) quadrant clinics per seasonal year. WSSA affiliated associations must apply to hold entry level 8 quadrant clinics at the July WSSA board meeting. Clinic dates must be set by October 15 of that calendar year and submitted to WSSA by that date. If the deadline is missed the planned quadrant clinic can be given to another WSSA affiliated association.

Entry Level 8 Referee Quadrant Clinic – 16 Hours Minimum

1. No minimum number of participants is required, but they must be aged 12 or older.
2. Upon receipt of required paperwork, instructor fee and travel expenses will be paid by WSSA.
3. The instructor fee is \$350.00. If there is more than 1 instructor the fee is split.
4. If a refresher clinic is held at the same time as the quadrant clinic an instructor fee of \$100.00 and instructor travel expenses will be paid by WSSA.

ASSOCIATION SPONSORED CLINICS

Entry Level 8 Referee – 16 Hours Minimum

1. The instructor fee is \$350.00.
2. WSSA will pay the instructor fee if an association has ten (10) or more individuals (age 12 or older) pass the test; if fewer than ten (10) pass the sponsoring association is responsible for instructor fee.
3. The sponsoring association pays for travel, lodging and meal expenses incurred by the instructor.

Level 9 Referee/Bridge Clinic – 8 to 10 Hours

1. The instructor fee is \$200.00.
2. WSSA will pay the instructor fee if an association has ten (10) or more individuals (age 12 or older) pass the test; if fewer than ten (10) pass the sponsoring association is responsible for instructor fee.
3. The sponsoring association pays for travel, lodging and meal expenses incurred by the instructor.

Refresher Clinic - 5 Hours

For clinics not held in conjunction with an Entry Level 8 Referee Clinic

1. Instructor fee is \$100.00.
2. Sponsoring association pays all clinic expenses; there is NO reimbursement from WSSA.

To receive reimbursement

The host or sponsoring association submits to the WSSA office:

1. A completed Referee Clinic Reimbursement form
2. A completed Referee Attendance form.
